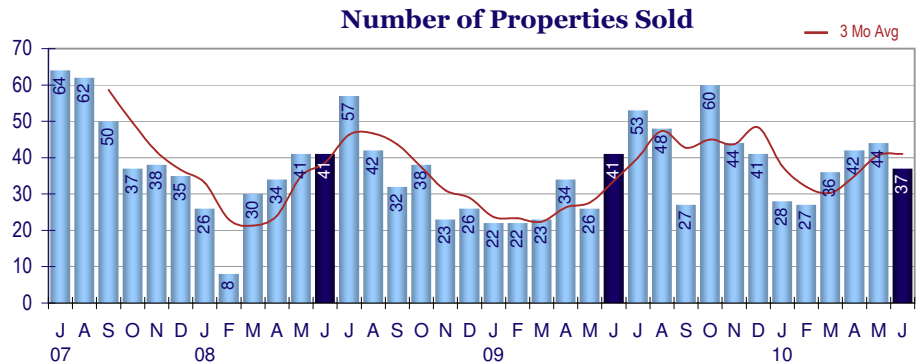

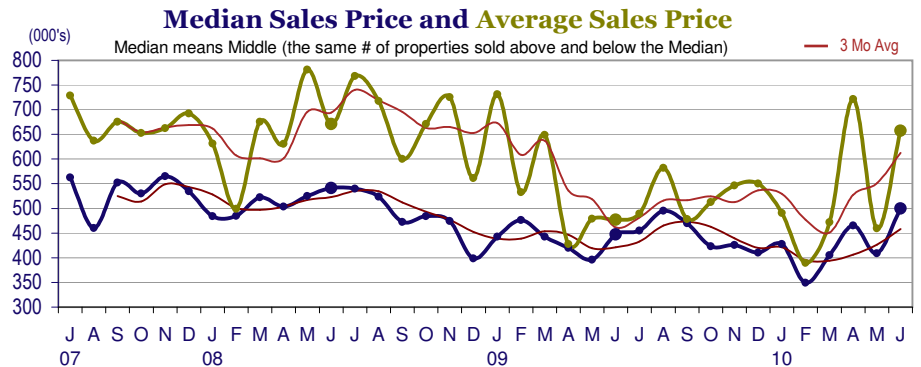
Property Sales

June Property sales were 37, down 9.8% from 41 in June of 2009 and 15.9% lower than the 44 sales last month. June 2010 sales were at their lowest level compared to June of 2009 and 2008. June YTD sales of 214 are running 27.4% ahead of last year's year-to-date sales of 168.



Prices

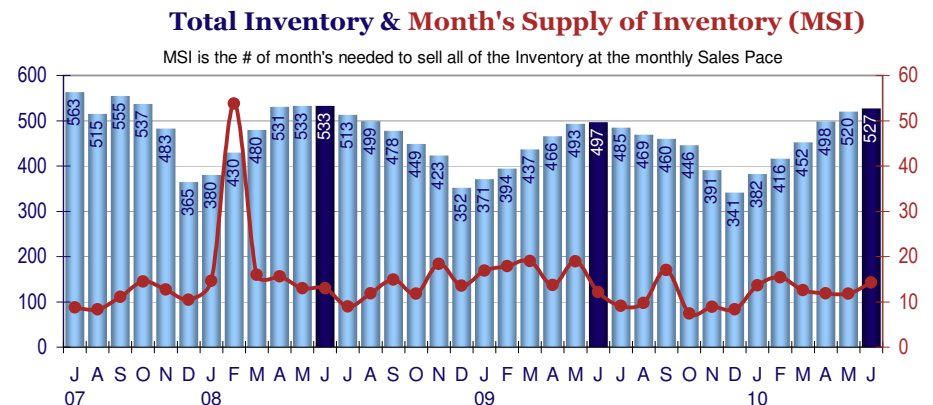
The Median Sales Price in June was \$500,000, up 11.9% from \$447,000 in June of 2009 and up 22.2% from \$409,000 last month. The Average Sales Price in June was \$657,280, up 37.8% from \$476,998 in June of 2009 and up 43.0% from \$459,506 last month. June 2010 ASP was at a mid range compared to June of 2009 and 2008.



Inventory & MSI

The Total Inventory of Properties available for sale as of June was 527, up 1.3% from 520 last month and up 6.0% from 497 in June of last year. June 2010 Inventory was at a mid level compared with June of 2009 and 2008.

A comparatively lower MSI is more beneficial for sellers while a higher MSI is better for buyers. The June 2010 MSI of 14.2 months was at its highest level compared with June of 2009 and 2008.



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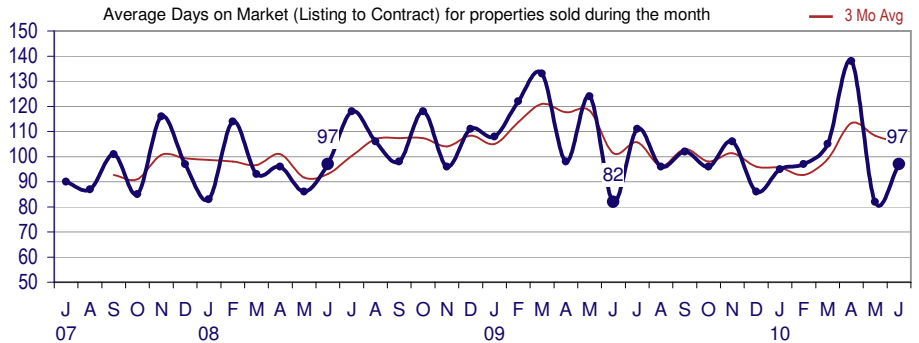


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Market Time

The average Days On Market (DOM) shows how many days the average Property is on the market before it sells. An upward trend in DOM tends to indicate a move towards more of a Buyer's market, a downward trend a move towards more of a Seller's market. The DOM for June was 97, up 18.3% from 82 days last month and up 18.3% from 82 days in June of last year. The June 2010 DOM was at a mid level compared with June of 2009 and 2008.

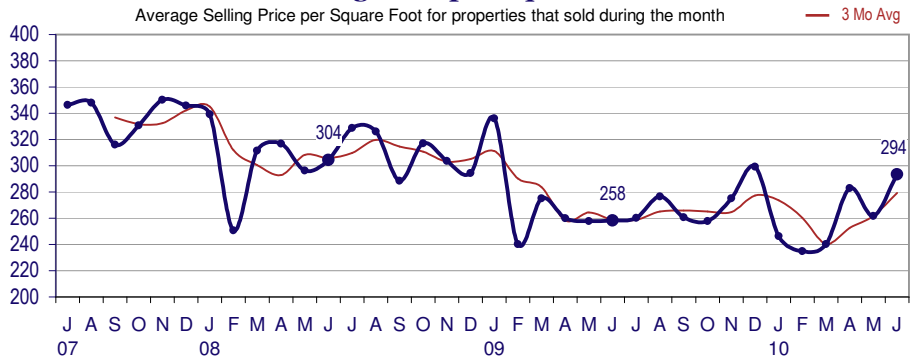
Days On Market for Sold Properties



Selling Price per Square Foot

The Selling Price per Square Foot is a great indicator for the direction of Property values. Since Median Sales Price and Average Sales price can be impacted by the 'mix' of high or low end Properties in the market, the selling price per square foot is a more normalized indicator on the direction of Property values. The June 2010 Selling Price per Square Foot of \$294 was up 12.2% from \$262 last month and up 13.7% from 258 in June of last year.

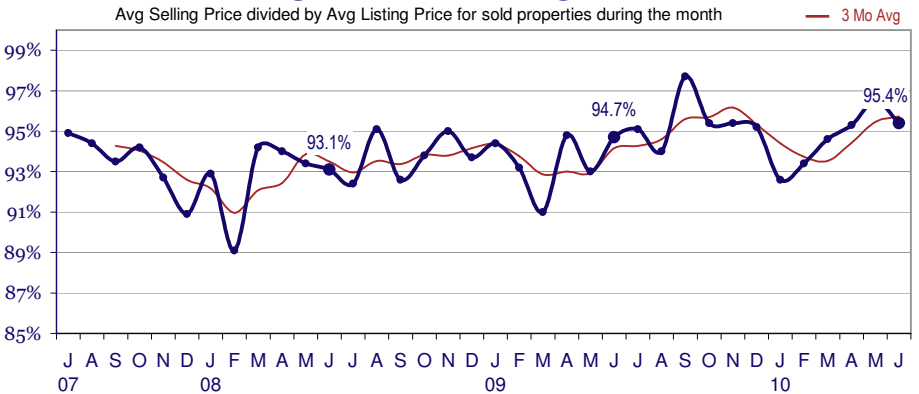
Selling Price per Square Foot



Selling Price vs Original Listing Price

The Selling Price vs Original Listing Price reveals the average amount that Sellers are agreeing to come down from their original list price. The lower the ratio is below 100% the more of a Buyer's market exists, a ratio at or above 100% indicates more of a Seller's market. The June 2010 Selling Price vs Original List Price of 95.4% was down from 96.5% last month and up from 94.7% in June of last year.

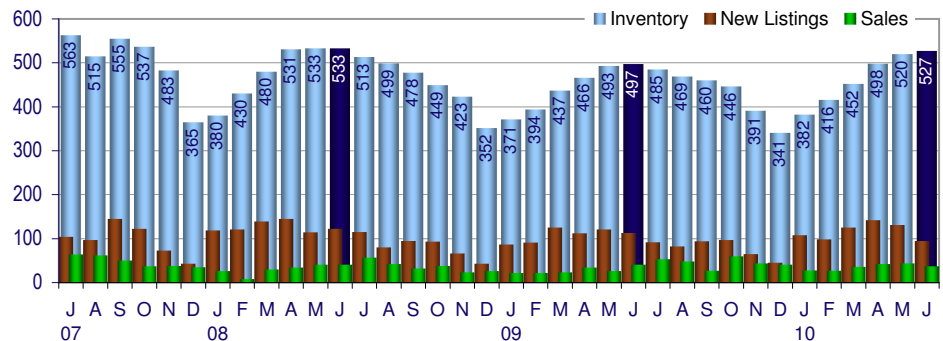
Selling Price versus Listing Price Ratio



Inventory / New Listings / Sales

This last view of the market combines monthly inventory of Properties for sale along with New Listings and Sales. The graph shows the basic annual seasonality of the market as well as the relationship between these items. The number of New Listings in June 2010 was 95, down 27.5% from 131 last month and down 15.9% from 113 in June of last year.

Inventory / New Listings / Sales



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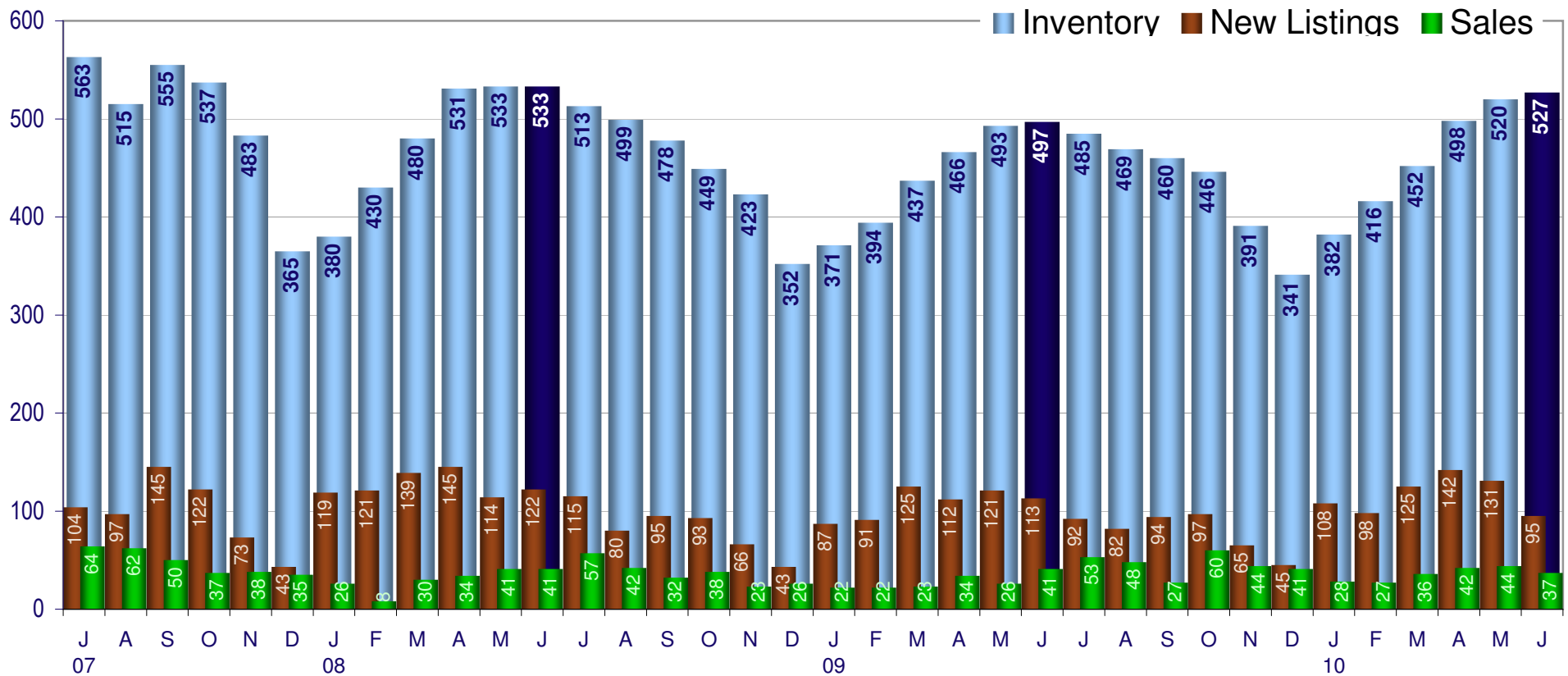
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
