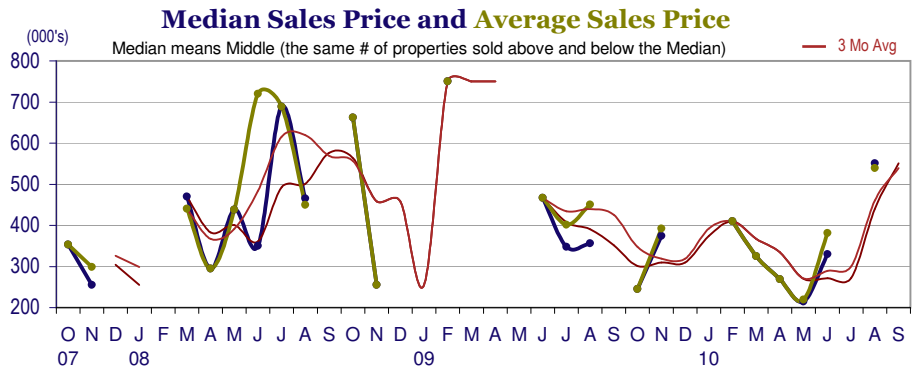
## Property Sales

September Property sales were 0, up from 0 in September of 2009 and 100.0% lower than the 4 sales last month. September 2010 sales were at their highest level compared to September of 2009 and 2008. September YTD sales of 18 are running 38.5% ahead of last year's year-to-date sales of 13.



## Prices

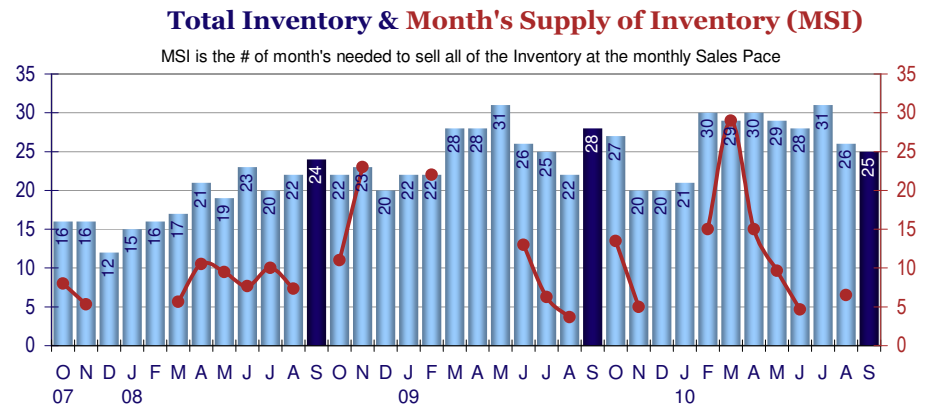
The Median Sales Price in September was \$0, up from \$0 in September of 2009 and down 100.0% from \$551,000 last month. The Average Sales Price in September was \$0, up from \$0 in September of 2009 and down 100.0% from \$539,250 last month. September 2010 ASP was at the highest level compared to September of 2009 and 2008.



## Inventory & MSI

The Total Inventory of Properties available for sale as of September was 25, down 3.8% from 26 last month and down 10.7% from 28 in September of last year. September 2010 Inventory was at a mid level compared with September of 2009 and 2008.

A comparatively lower MSI is more beneficial for sellers while a higher MSI is better for buyers. The September 2010 MSI of 0.0 months was at its highest level compared with September of 2009 and 2008.



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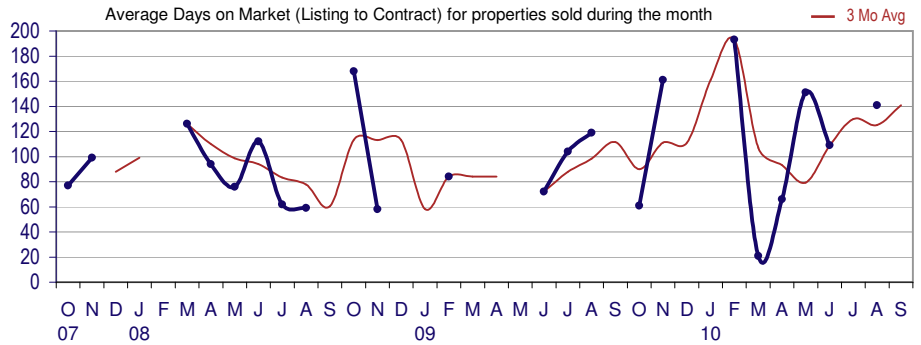


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## Market Time

The average Days On Market (DOM) shows how many days the average Property is on the market before it sells. An upward trend in DOM tends to indicate a move towards more of a Buyer's market, a downward trend a move towards more of a Seller's market. The DOM for September was 0, down 100.0% from 141 days last month and up from 0 days in September of last year. The September 2010 DOM was at its lowest level compared with September of 2009 and 2008.

## Selling Price vs Original Listing Price

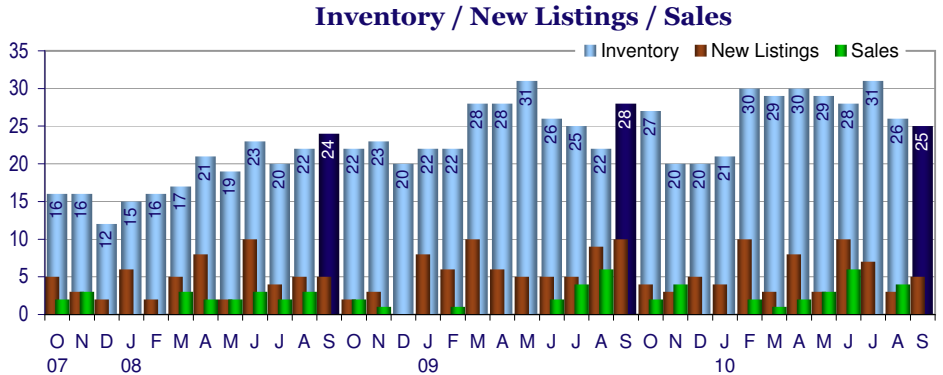
The Selling Price vs Original Listing Price reveals the average amount that Sellers are agreeing to come down from their original list price. The lower the ratio is below 100% the more of a Buyer's market exists, a ratio at or above 100% indicates more of a Seller's market. The September 2010 Selling Price vs Original List Price of 0.0% was down from 93.6% last month and up from 0.0% in September of last year.

## Inventory / New Listings / Sales

This last view of the market combines monthly inventory of Properties for sale along with New Listings and Sales. The graph shows the basic annual seasonality of the market as well as the relationship between these items. The number of New Listings in September 2010 was 5, up 66.7% from 3 last month and down 50.0% from 10 in September of last year.



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
